### **TRANSPORTATION:**

Institute buses are provided for students to attend clinical postings, community area visits etc.

### **VACATION:**

4 weeks vacation is planned yearly, 2 weeks during December as Mid-Term Leave, 1 week as Preparatory holidays before Annual Exams and 1 week after Final exams as Annual Leave.

### **SICK LEAVE:**

Students are eligible for 10 days of sick leave. However if a student is not able to return in time due to illness, the Principal should be intimated immediately followed by a written explanation. On return the student should submit a Medical Certificate, issued by a Registered Medical Practitioner stating the full particulars of the illness and treatment. Days availed over and above the prescribed number of sick leave will be considered as absent. Sick leave is not accumulative.

### **PREPARATORY HOLIDAYS:**

1 week/annum before Annual Examination.

### **EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:**

A number of opportunities are provided for the students to develop their skills and talents at various levels such as indoor-outdoor games and sports, picnics etc. are organized to enhance social interaction and participation of friendly competitive attitude. Students are encouraged to make use

of these facilities. Membership to the Student Association (S.A.) on local, state and national levels offer ample scope for development of their knowledge and skills. Parent Teacher Association (PTA) is arranged once in an academic year, serving an opportunity to every parent to be a part of the Institution and in turn know the progress of their ward and provide their support to the Institution in imparting value based education.

### DECLARATION OF RESULTS (Grading and Credit system is followed)

#### Criteria For Passing:

- Main Subjects: A candidate is declared to have passed the examination in a subject, if she/he secures 50% minimum passing marks in theory and 50% in practical separately. Both theory & practicals, a candidate has to secure minimum of 50% marks in the University conducted examination.
- Following exams shall be conducted as College exam and minimum pass is 50% (C Grade) and to be sent to the University for inclusion in the marks sheet and shall be considered for calculating aggregate.
  - Communicative English
  - Health/Nursing Informatics and Technology
  - Professionalism, Professional Values and Ethic including Bioethics
  - Introduction to Forensic Nursing Indian Laws
  - Minimum pass marks shall be 40% (P grade/4 point) for English only and elective modules.
  - Minimum pass marks shall be 50% in each of the Theory and practical papers separately except in English.
  - The student has to pass in all mandatory modules placed within courses and the pass mark for each module is 50% (C Grade). The allotted percentage of marks will be included in the internal assessment of College/University Examination.

### ASSESSMENT GUIDELINES

#### 1. Grading of Performance

Based on the performance, each students shall be awarded a final grade at the end of the semester for each course. Absolute grading is used by converting the marks to grade, based on predetermined class intervals.

UGC 10 point grading system is used with pass grade modified.

- For nursing courses and all other courses – Pass is at C Grade (5 grade point) 50% and above
- For English and electives – Pass is at P Grade (4 grade point) 40% and above
- Computation of Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) and Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA)
- SGPA is the weighted average of the grade points obtained in all courses by the student during the semester (All courses excluding English and electives)

Note: Passing in more than one attempt shall be placed in pass class / grade irrespective of their percentage of marks secured in the examination.

### Carry over Benefit:

The candidate shall appear for exams in each semester:

- The candidate shall have cleared all the previous examinations before appearing for fifth semester examination. However, the candidates shall be permitted to attend the consecutive semesters.
- The candidate shall have cleared all the previous examinations before appearing for seventh semester examination. However, the candidates shall be permitted to attend the consecutive semesters.
- The candidate shall have cleared all the previous examinations before appearing for final year examination.

The maximum period to complete the course successfully should not exceed 8 years.

First year -8 Common subjects, 1 Subsidiary subject

Second Year -5 Common subjects, 1 Subsidiary subject

**ATTENDANCE:** A minimum of 80% of attendance is required in theory and 100% attendance in practical separately in each subject.

**INTERNAL ASSESSMENT:** There shall be continuous internal assessment. There shall be a minimum of three sessional exams & two assignments in each subject, the average of which shall form the marks for internal assessment. A student must secure at least 50% of total marks fixed for Internal Assessment in a particular subject in order to be eligible in University Examination.

### DECLARATION OF RESULTS

#### 1. Criterial For Passing:

A candidate shall secure at least 50% of total marks in each subject in theory paper and practical separately except in English. The marks obtained in the internal assessment shall be added to the marks obtained in the University Examination for each subject for computing the 50% minimum marks required for passing.

In case of English a candidate shall secure at least 33% of maximum marks for passing (inclusive of internal assessment and College Examination)

#### 2. Declaration Of Class:

##### A. A candidate obtained

##### C. Carry over Benefit:

A candidate who has passed in any of the five subjects but failed in any of the three or less subjects is permitted to proceed the 2nd year. The candidate has to pass the carried over subjects before appearing in the 2nd year University Examination.

A minimum of 80% of attendance is required in theory and 100% attendance in practical separately in each subject.

### INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

There shall be continuous internal assessment. There shall be a minimum of two tests; two assignments in each subject, the average of which shall form the marks for internal assessment. A student must secure at least 50% of total marks fixed for Internal Assessment in a particular subject in order to be eligible in University Examination in that subject

### DECLARATION OF RESULTS

#### 1. Criteria For Passing

**A. Common Subjects:** A candidate shall secure in each of the common subjects not less than 50% marks prescribed for University examination (40 out of 80) in theory papers (exclusive of internal assessment marks).

**B. Nursing Specialty Subjects:** A candidate shall secure not less than 50% marks prescribed for University examination separately in theory (40 out of 80) and in practical examination (40 out of 80) exclusive of internal assessment marks.

## 2. Declaration Of Class

### A. A candidate obtained

75% & above	- Pass with Distinction	passing in more than one attempt shall be placed in pass class irrespective of the percentage of marks secured in the examination

B. A candidate will be awarded University rank only when she/he clears all the subjects of the University examination in the first attempt in all the years.

**C. Carry over Benefit:** A candidate who has passed in any of the two subjects, but failed in any two subjects, is permitted to proceed to the 2nd year. However, such a candidate shall have to pass all the failed subjects before becoming eligible to appear for 2nd year M.Sc. Nursing University examination.

## ATTENDANCE:

A minimum of 75% of attendance is required in theory and practical (100%) separately in each subject, however the total clinical experience prescribed must be completed before the issue of diploma certificate.

## INTERNAL ASSESSMENT:

A candidate must secure 50% of marks in Internal Assessment, separately, in each Theory subjects and Practicals.

## DECLARATION OF RESULTS:

### 1. CRITERIA FOR PASSING:

A candidate is declared to have passed the examination in a subject, if she/he secures 50% minimum passing marks in theory and 50% in practicals separately.

Results of examination shall be graded on aggregate marks of the entire 3 years of the training program as given in the declaration of class.

### 2. DECLARATION OF CLASS:

#### A. A candidate obtained

80% & above	Pass with Distinction

#### B. Carry Over Benefit:

If a student fails in one theory/practical she/he shall be allowed to proceed to the next academic year, and will sit for the next supplementary examination within six month of the Annual examination. If a student fails two or more theory papers/ practicals, she/he will not be allowed to proceed to the next year. She/he shall sit for supplementary examination for the failed subjects/practicals, but shall be eligible for the next academic years examination on after clearing in the failed subjects.

- Age limit: 17 as on 31st December of the year of admission

**COURSE DURATION:** The duration of the BPT Course shall be four and half years including internship of six months. No candidate shall be awarded degree certificate without successfully completing six months of Internship.

**ATTENDANCE:** A candidate is required to attend at least 80 percent of the total classes conducted in a year in all subjects prescribed for that year, separately, in theory and practical / clinical to become eligible to appear for the University examination in the first attempt.

**INTERNAL ASSESSMENT:** It shall be based on evaluation of periodic tests assignments, clinical presentations, etc that shall be conducted

throughout the course in the college. A minimum of two sessional examinations during I, II, III and final year and the average of the two examination marks will be considered as per the University norms.

**SCHEDULE OF EXAMINATION:** There will be two University examinations in a year which will be conducted as per notification issued by the University from time to time. First, Second, Third and Final Examinations of BPT course shall be held at the end of 1st year, 2nd year, 3rd year and 4th year respectively. The examination for main subjects shall be conducted by the University and for subsidiary subjects by the respective college.

**CRITERIA FOR PASS:** The subjects are broadly classified into Main Subjects and Subsidiary Subjects.

- Main Subjects:** A candidate is declared to have passed university examination in a subject, if she/he secures 50% of the marks in theory and 50% in practical separately.
  - Subsidiary Subjects:** For a pass in Subsidiary subjects, a candidate shall secure 35% of the total marks prescribed for the subject.

- A candidate having appeared in all the subjects in the same examination.
- A candidate having passed in all subjects in the same examination in the first attempt.
- A candidate passing the University examination in more than one attempt shall be placed in Pass class irrespective of the percentage of marks secured by him/her in the examination.
- The marks obtained by a candidate in the subsidiary subjects shall not be considered for award of Class or Rank.

### CARRY OVER BENEFITS

**I Year [5 main subjects]:** A candidate who has failed in I year is permitted to carry any two of the five main subjects and shall have to pass these subjects before appearing for the II year examination.

**II Year [4 main subjects]:** A candidate who has failed in II year is permitted to carry any one of the four main subjects and shall have to pass these subjects before appearing for the III year examination.

**III Year [5 Main subjects]:** A candidate is permitted to carry any two of the failed subjects and shall have to pass these subjects before appearing for the final year examination.

**Subsidiary subject** - may be carried over by a failed candidate but shall have to pass the same before appearing for the final year examination.
